CPI PROPERTY GROUP - GSG Berlin continues its expansion with the acquisition of an industrial complex in Ullsteinstraße in Berlin-Tempelhof

CPI PROPERTY GROUP announces that its German subsidiary Gewerbesiedlungs-Gesellschaft (GSG Berlin) acquired the industrial complex Ullsteinstraße 73 in Berlin-Tempelhof for EUR 6.9 Million. Originally, it was a factory for electronic devices built by Philips between 1955 and 1956.

The industrial complex is close to Tempelhofer Hafen (Tempelhof Harbour) and the subway station Ullsteinstraße; an emerging region that has performed very well in recent years. It offers architecturally impressive factory buildings with attached commercial buildings. Highlight of the area is a shed hall with ceiling heights of up to 10 meters. The five buildings offer a total of approximately 16,600 square meters. The unit sizes vary from 50 to 1,400 square meters and offer production, storage and office space for rent.
